

Yahweh God and Jesus Christ, Are they part of the Trinity?

In the Garden of Eden, Satan asked Eve the following question:-

Did God say, you must not eat from the tree of good and evil?

This question was not a question for information, though Eve thought it was, so she gave her interpretation of it!

Satan knew what God said, so why was Satan asking?

Well Satan knew what the information was, he knew God’s understanding of what was said; so what he was trying to do is find out what Eves interpretation was and lead her into a trap by inferring: 'Is it really so!'

Satan was trying to seduce Eve into believing the wrong understanding of the correct set of facts or information before her.

This has repeatedly happened ever since that episode in the Garden of Eden.

Satan tried with Jesus in the wilderness by quoting the Bible saying:

‘Is it not written that the Son of God has the power to call upon the angels to protect himself from becoming harmed?

Jesus knew precisely what was going through Satan’s mind!

Jesus also knew the correct why to answer him - Jesus understood the scriptures!

If someone knows the truth, why do they put out misunderstanding?

There are two basic reasons:-

1. Ignorance.

2. Deliberate, in order to deceive.

First Century Christians.

Rev. 15v3-4 Saying: Great and marvellous are your works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are your ways, thou King of saints. Who shall not fear you, O Lord, and glorify your name? For only you are holy: for all nations shall come and worship before you, for your judgements are made manifest.

We see how Almighty God is King of the saints, while we knew Jesus is wedded to the saints. Hence different.

John 14v28 You have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If you love me, you would rejoice, because I said, I go to my father: for my father is greater than I.

If the above is true how did the Trinity get established?

Between 325 and 380 AD the Christians established the Trinity to try and bring in more Christians by appealing to the new philosophical reasoning running through the intellectual masses propounded by Plato (Greek) and Thiroal (Jewish) philosophers. It was establishing a human mystic to appeal to a wider audience.

Is Yahweh God part of this Trinity Deity?

Ex. 6v3 And I appeared to Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but my name was not known to them as Yahweh (Jehovah).

Hence we see how before pharaoh, Yahweh (Jehovah) God was only known as The Almighty God to show that there was only one, unique God and was above all the false gods that pharaoh chose to know. However the Israelites were chosen as God's people and given the opportunity to know God's Personal name.

Ex. 20v3 Thou shall have no other gods before me! Thou shall not make any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: You shall not bow yourself down or serve them: for I am the Lord your God, I am a jealous God.

Again we see that there is only One God.

Deut. 6v4 Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord.

Quite simply and clearly said, there should be no miss understanding with that statement. People may argue that it was perhaps 'simple,' said for, simple-minded people (1600 BC), while now we are sophisticated and can understand sophisticated things - like the Trinity!

Well much later at about 600 BC we read this statement:-

Isa. 45v23-24 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, that unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear Surely, shall one say, in the Lord have I righteousness and strength: even to him shall men come; and all that are incensed against him shall be ashamed.

Is this clear or are we required to have a mystery?

Here people are to understand! Those who understand will have everlasting life.

We are not going to be in a perpetual darkness or mystery!

Isa. 43v10-12 You are my witnesses, says the Lord, and my servant whom I have chosen: that you may know and understand that I am He: Before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. I, even I, am the Lord; and beside me there is no saviour. I have declared, and have saved, and I have showed, when there was no strange god among you, therefore you are my witnesses, says the Lord, that I am God.

So we now know, have faith, witness, understand what it is about and have faith in that understanding.

People may argue Helios is used in the plural, hence it means two or more 'Gods'. This is the wrong interpretation of the plural, in those days plural sometimes means to over stress the singular - make the single even more powerful by stressing the singular as a plural. An example would be queen Victoria saying 'We are not amused'.

It did not mean everyone at court was not amused, but she being the 'most important' spoke for everybody and called herself – “**we**”.

Judg. 3v7 And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord, and forgot the Lord their God, and served Baalim and the groves. Therefore the anger of the Lord was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushan-rishataim king of Mesopotamia for eight years.

Only the Israelites are brought to task because as representatives of Almighty God they had done bad in forsaking Him. Baal means 'lord' in plural.

Defining special characters of Almighty God is as bad as splitting Him up - it all leads to confusion. The Bible instructs us not to be confused.

Eph. 4v4-6 There is one body, and one spirit, even as you are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, One faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in all.

Why confuse things with a mystery - it is all clear!

Only Satan likes a cover-up so that he can deceive, as shown in the Garden of Eden.

John 1v14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Glory for the only begotten Son of God from God.

1John 4v9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

Heb. 2v14 So because the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy Satan who had the power of death over us.

Jesus Christ will bring Satan's power of death over us to nothing because of the self-sacrifice of God's beloved Son.

Dan. 7v25-27 He shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and half a time. But the judgement shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy it unto the end. And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole earth, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.

John 5v25-27 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they who hear and believe shall have life. For as the Father has life in himself, so has he given to the Son to have life himself; And has also given him authority to execute judgement, because he is the Son of man.

The Father has given all authority to Jesus Christ.

Acts 10v42 And he commanded us to preach unto the people, and to testify that it is he which was ordained of God to be the judge of those alive and those dead.

Jesus says I am the way to Almighty God:-

John 14v6 Jesus said to him:- 'I am the way, the truth, and the life, no man comes to the Father except by me.'

Satan prompts us to think:-

If Jesus Christ is to be the judge, the king, way and truth, then surely he must be Almighty God as well.'

John 5v18 Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the Sabbath, but also said that God was his Father - making himself equal with God (so argued the Pharisees).

My Father keeps working and so do I, even though I may be breaking the Sabbath as interpreted by the Jews. Making Jesus equal to the Father was a charge said by the Pharisees - not by Jesus! - hence the interpretation was instigated by Satan!

Here again we have a statement, where Satan is challenging both Jesus at the time and subtly our thinking through the Pharisees.

John 8v28 Then Jesus said to them: When you have lifted up the Son of man, then you shall know that I am He, and that I do nothing of myself, but as my Father has taught me, I speak these things truthfully.

You will realise that I am telling the truth just as the Father taught me these things that I learn. Clearly, how can Almighty God be taught and also learn things - Almighty God has never been in the position to be taught or learn things (certainly not within this planet's 5 billion year existence)

Luke 4.18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he has sent me to heal the broken-hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised.

John 3.16-17 For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever, believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent his Son into the world, not to condemn it, but through him the world might be saved.

Heb. 7v7 And without all contradiction the less is blessed by the better.

All these different examples show that a 'Being' is taking orders and obeying them from Someone superior.

Psalm 45v2-7 Thou art fairer than the children of men; grace is poured into your lips; therefore God has blessed thee for ever. Gird your sword upon your thigh, o most mighty, with your glory and majesty. And in your majesty ride prosperously because of truth and meekness and righteousness; and your right hands shall teach terrible things. Your arrows are sharp in the heart of the kings enemies; because the people fall under you. Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; the sceptre of your kingdom is a right sceptre. You love righteousness, and hate wickedness; therefore God, your God has anointed you with oil of gladness above your fellows.

Here Jesus Christ learned obedience from the things he suffered. The Almighty God had not got to learn and obey!

But Jesus Christ could learn to obey his Father - and was glad to do so, to fulfil his will.

Jesus prayed to his Father, and not to himself (numerous examples to show this) and hence Almighty God will and has elevated Jesus to kingship.

1Cor. 15v24,28 When the end comes and Jesus delivers up the kingdom to God the Father, when Jesus has put down all rule and authority and power

And when all things are subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him that God may be all in all.

Here Jesus subjected himself to the will of Almighty God after he has sorted everything out.

We see from Eden - Israelites - True Christians; the apparent mystery is in reality totally clear - it is no mystery!

So is Jesus Christ and Almighty God part of the Trinity from what we have read? -

I'm sure that we do know the answer to that!
