Love is able to change a Person

Occasionally I take a whole suite being a week's worth of "Prayer for the Day" because it is given by one person and it enables me to analyse beyond merely the content of any particular day to highlight a more important inference delivered by a multiple set of talks.

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Also an interesting feature that I have noticed with religious leaders is that the more qualifications personally accumulated, or higher up 'the religious ladder' the religious leaders seem to climb then the more divorced from The Reality of fulfilling Yahweh's Desire they seem to be!

Perhaps that is what The Bible calls 'The wisdom of the world'.

Now that appears to be 'fighting' talk! – But I do <u>not</u> intend it to be, but rather it be more of a catalyst to initiate a rethink towards which direction <u>worldly</u> Christian leaders are focusing their preaching effort so that they <u>might</u> fulfil Yahweh's Desire rather than the desire of some other god – being Satan who presently holds the custodianship of this <u>now failing world</u> – <u>all precisely</u> as The Bible so <u>clearly</u> tells us.

The problem is that 'no one' reads The Bible today – to try and understand <u>precisely</u> what Yahweh is teaching us – the evidence for this stark claim is within 'the real fruit' of peoples' actions ("real" used to mean "<u>acceptable</u> to Yahweh" – being "to <u>assist in fulfilling</u> Yahweh's Plan").

There are a few humans having an intrinsic nature that is genuine in helping people but the vast majority of humans merely pay 'lip service' to "religion" (see Glossary) when it suits them and then promptly disregard it – **for it has no real meaning or relevance in their life!**

The reason <u>why</u> it has <u>no meaning</u> is for it <u>makes no sense</u> in their lives being what they see occurring around them – but a common denominator of worldly religions clearly stated is that:

"We must do nice things to one another through love expressed", initiated by a 'good' founder who sacrificed himself in some manner to the world in whom we must 'believe in', then throw in 'a god' or a 'few gods' for good measure thus giving an apparent 3rd hand to substantiate what is stated, and finally that if you are "good" (by what criteria?) then your ethereal soul shall wander up to be with the god(s) when you die.

And that is about the sum of what is taught in <u>all</u> worldly religions – including the very <u>worldly</u> Christian Religion practiced by the vast majority of 'Christians'!

There is <u>no</u> evident Logical Plan – because all <u>worldly</u> religions (being <u>intrinsically false</u> to Yahweh's Desire) have <u>no</u> logical or structural plan which <u>atheists can so **correctly** see! Thus <u>all worldly</u> religions are just like a trawler net that drag human 'fish' into them and never let them go again for a number of reasons (all this I discuss elsewhere on this website).</u>

And sadly, when Jesus carefully explained about Yahweh's Acceptable Year during his ministry being <u>The Intrinsic Difference</u> to differentiate "The Absolute Truth" from <u>all</u> the <u>worldly</u> religions operating in 31 CE <u>and</u> those to appear in the future during The Gospel Age then this Plan became lost to The World at large after John's death during the closing years of the 1st century CE.

Thus what Apostles (appointed by Yahweh 'to tell') should and did preach - to give us The New Testament which answers The Old Testament through Yahweh's carefully structured Plan of salvation which is **never** taught today – so this <u>most</u> 'basic of knowledge' is <u>not</u> known within The World and humans consequently <u>become directionless</u> – just being blown about by the wind (see "air" in Glossary). Thus they resort to "doing their own thing" being pandemic as we now witness today – for there is <u>no accountability</u> any more – but just do what you can get away with in society! Yahweh's Acceptable Year <u>is</u> actually <u>the most logical and righteous Plan</u> to extract humans from the present mess they operate within – but it is <u>never</u> taught by those <u>worldly</u> Christian leaders who are so fortunately placed to actually have The Material at their finger tips – it reminds me of Jesus' parable of The Rich Man and Lazarus!

Well after that rousing introduction shall we read together what Ruth being a Reverend and Dr (so she must know about what she is speaking) and see if she is able to tell us about Yahweh's most wonderful plan being The Fulfillment of Yahweh's Acceptable Year that logically explains <u>why</u> humans are in such a mess and <u>how</u> Yahweh is going to extract us out of it – so that we have leadership and direction.

For that is precisely what Jesus <u>commanded</u> of his Apostles being those humans who claim to come in his name (then and now)!

So let us now read six days worth of talk and prayers to see if we can learn what makes <u>True</u> Christianity the reason why Jesus came on this Planet to redeem his creation – being utterly separate from all <u>worldly</u> religions (<u>including</u> the prevailing <u>worldly</u> Christianity) being all that come from the present god of this world – Satan – designed to confuse and fragment – as we witness throughout history up to and including today.

I have a friend who says often, "To love someone is to reveal to them that they are beautiful." And I think that, in a sense captures the essence of what St. Paul was writing about love in one of his letters. His words are probably some of the best known in the bible. They are beautiful words and very poetic. But when we come to really read them, to try to grasp what is being said, they're actually quite difficult, just as love can sometimes be quite difficult. They are challenging words. They're certainly not about a romantic feeling where it's roses all the way, with no encounters with conflict or change or stretching.

In fact, when we look at the way St Paul defines love in this letter to the Corinthian Christians, we either shy away from it, or else make a decision, an act of will to follow its way, no matter what - always, I believe, with the help of God. It would be impossible in our own strength. The American theologian Eugene Peterson's paraphrase of Paul's words might well shake us out of any complacency caused by their very familiarity:

Love never gives up

Love cares more for others than for self.

Love doesn't want what it doesn't have.

Love doesn't strut,

Doesn't have a swelled head,

Doesn't force itself on others,

Isn't always 'me first'

Doesn't fly off the handle,

Doesn't keep score of the sins of others

Trusts God always,

Always looks for the best,

Never looks back,

But keeps going to the end.

Dear God, would you give me your grace to love like that. And this day, help me to reveal to someone that they are beautiful. Amen

Monday, 30 June 2008

I'm convinced that one of the biggest desires in the human heart is to belong, is to know there is someone in this world who cares that you woke up this morning. To be at home with ourselves, with other people and with God is what most of us yearn for but the reality is that many of us are not. With fast-developing, high powered technology that is supposed to improve communication and yet, paradoxically, can squeeze the life out of ordinary relating, many people are feeling lost and lonely. There is no place that is home for them, There is no-one who really listens to them, There seems to be no sense of purpose to fill the aching gap inside them.

One of the things that gives most pleasure in life is looking forward to something. It could be a well-deserved holiday after a long period of hard work, or a special event in your life, or the return of someone you love after a long absence. A number of years ago, there was a very popular poster. It pictured a caterpillar hanging on a branch of a tree. The caption underneath was, "Please be patient. God hasn't finished with me yet!" To hang on to the fact that God hasn't finished with any of us can be a source of continuing hope and encouragement. As we do the little things we see about us, things like reaching out a hand in friendship to someone who is different, like lighting a candle instead of cursing the darkness, God, by his spirit, works through them in ways we could never imagine. We begin to see that where we 'can't', he can. Dear God, today I may feel like cursing the darkness. Help me instead to light a candle. Amen

Friday, 4 July 2008

One of the least extolled, but most necessary, virtues in life is that of endurance, of simply gritting your teeth and keeping on going, even when there is very little or no obvious encouragement to do so.

And yet we can get a sense that God has entrusted us with something in our lives. It might be only a flickering awareness of some gift or grace or calling, but it's there. You may not even have been aware of it most of the time. But the fact of the matter is: you and I are here for a purpose. The purpose primarily is to 'be yourself', to be as fully as possible the unique person God has created you to be.

We can waste so much time and energy comparing ourselves with other people, wishing we were like them. We can lack confidence and can be so fearful about taking a step into an unknown future, about doing something different that we remain stunted and never see beyond the limited horizons we've set for ourselves to the wide open spaces of God's dream for us.

John O'Donohue, the Irish writer, has a blessing for those who dare to hear a call to something more:

As far as you can, hold your confidence.

Do not allow your confusion to squander

This call which is loosening

Your roots in false ground,

That you might come free

From all you had outgrown.

Dear God, I want to be true to you and your dream for me, no matter what the obstacles. Today I give you my hopes and dreams and visions trusting that you will take care of who you are calling me to be. Amen

These talks and prayers sound so sweet – they 'please the ear' of the listener, make people think how wonderful things are – and thus just what The Almighty God desires to hear!

Or perhaps:

Are these words really so sweet? How do they relate to reality within this present world? And is it what Yahweh God being The Almighty God of The Universe really desires to hear? Let us now carefully analyse what was said to us by Ruth.

So after some 1700 words and 6 days of talk and prayer did we actually learn anything particular about Yahweh's Acceptable Year and anything that was specific to <u>True</u> Christianity that would separate it from all other forms of <u>worldly</u> religions?

Being one of two reasons specifically why Jesus came here on this Earth!

Well looking through all those words and remove just three pairs of words, being references to "St Paul" (used three times) and incidentally he was <u>not</u> quoted but rather a theologian, and afterwards a writer who was quoted profusely, (both having much <u>less grasp</u> of The Greater Reality than the Apostle Paul), then this piece could have been written by a <u>Muslim, Hindu or even a Sikh</u> thus showing <u>no</u> specific differentiation between <u>worldly</u> religions and what <u>Jesus</u> specifically taught us!

Jesus by name was not even mentioned throughout the six days!

And further, remove the word "God" from the script and it could have been written by an atheist!

On that conclusion – I would think Satan is 'rolling about laughing with glee' for Ruth has fulfilled his desire to confuse and make "the trumpet call indistinct" to **quote** the Apostle Paul!

So it is not looking good – is it – at first glance!

But an immediate counter would be:

Am I suggesting that these talks and prayers are wrong in any respect?

Yes and No! - Which is always the problem when trying to untangle misinformation.

For there is only one reason "misinformation" – or rather "disinformation" is put out to the recipient – being **to confuse** the recipient.

And it is "the confusion" that I need to clarify <u>because it is **pandemic**</u> within <u>worldly</u> Christianity because <u>all</u> the members of <u>worldly</u> Christianity have 'lost the plot', being 'The Goal' which Jesus specifically taught us during his ministry! Jesus taught of The Goal and how to get there, Satan wants <u>precisely the **opposite** to occur</u> because this knowledge hastens his demise (see "Satan's Desire" and "Yahweh's Desire" in Glossary to explain what all this means).

"The Evidence" is in the 20,000+ schisms within <u>worldly</u> Christianity and the fracturing of 'The Church of England' where everyone 'does their own thing' at the expense of what The Bible <u>specifically</u> teaches us!

Their demonstrable god is determined by their self-centred nature = Satan!

Saturday, 28 June 2008

I have a friend who says often, "To love someone is to reveal to them that they are beautiful."

Oh Really?

That is <u>not</u> what The Bible teaches us! For the Bible teaches us that The Father who loves the son shall chastise the son! Thus the son is initially <u>not</u> beautiful within their character and thus requires reform to <u>then</u> make that person 'beautiful'.

We are also told that we need to have 'the fire of refinement' upon us so as to remove the dross from our worldly character. The Bible also tells us that fire will be used to test our works – are they based upon straw or stone! So within the very 1st line of six days given to talks/prayers Ruth has already thrown in a worldly saying that is intrinsically confusing and will mislead if taken at a superficial level. However it is a 'lovely' sound-bite – endears the listener to the speaker – but it is not what The Bible teaches us.

The Bible teaches us of the reality of life and how our personality must be reformed to become Christ-like. It is just because of sound-bites like this that make <u>worldly</u> Christianity <u>an irrelevance</u> within the eyes of so many humans today when they look around them and see the world operating as it is!

Paul warns of false teachers beguiling the flock, making them feel good and <u>not</u> fulfilling Yahweh's Desire leading to the fallout within society today – appearing to be an irrelevance!

So what is wrong with what Ruth is stating and why is it skewed away from what The Bible teaches? The Bible teaches that humans <u>are</u> misguided by The World and require Yahweh's instruction to align themselves with what Yahweh Desires of them. In so many places it teaches us to <u>stay very close to accurate teaching</u> – else we <u>will</u> wander by following worldly teaching from sweet-talking teachers. Thus we need to take in <u>accurate</u> knowledge from a <u>proven source</u> (and not a worldly source) to reform ourselves – to put on that very necessary new personality, and upon having this new personality (by displaying it) where we become blind to worldly inducements

to steal our time, then we are coming close to imitating Jesus. All precisely as The Bible teaches us - all based upon quotes taken from The Bible.

True Love is expressed when one entity puts themselves out (being their time) to assist in the reform of another so that they too ultimately also learn to imitate Jesus' lifestyle.

Just saying "To love someone is to reveal to them that they are beautiful" is a <u>bogus</u> collection of words for it confuses what is required for that all important reform (as The Bible instructs <u>is</u> required for all sinful humans) by inferring that reform is unnecessary. This is essentially the teaching of the last 40 years to children in western society and they grow up to become 'brats' – where sadly more harsh remedial correction is required to reform the hapless person because their brain has become seared by habit. There is now growing realization that children should not be bought up like this but in a more balanced manner where they need to be taught that sometimes they are <u>not</u> that beautiful and are most unpleasant – but that is only done <u>because you really love and care for them</u> – and thus <u>not</u> behaving as a 'yes' person – being someone who does not truly care, but is being blown by the prevailing conditions (see James.1v6-8)!

Incidentally – can Ruth contact me by the email route given with a quote in The Bible that might support what she has just written here? I know the whole Bible fairly well and know there is nothing like that anywhere within it! Thus she has taken a phrase from The World which is one given to confuse, publicised it, so that it detracts us specifically away from what The Bible teaches us!

And I think that, in a sense captures the essence of what St. Paul was writing about love in one of his letters.

I think it might be useful to quote The Apostle Paul here <u>within context</u>. Incidentally, I do not like the word "saint" for it is a much over used word created by those of the world who have assumed that they are in the position of God and thus can create saints for <u>their own indulgence</u>. Jesus taught us that even he was not in the position to decide who was to sit to the left or the right of him – but only his Father being Yahweh - The Almighty God of The Universe. The Bible also teaches that we are not to judge our fellow brother given in a negative sense; – but because no differentiation was specified, then it is correct to assume that we should neither do it in a positive sense – which substantiates my quote of Jesus! – Else it could be misused as we now witness today – where 'saints' are 'milked' <u>for anything</u> to satisfy the self-indulgence of those alive today at both ends of the spectrum (and for those in between)!

For we are told that we can only come to Yahweh through Jesus! – So why the need for a 'saint' as 'dressed up' today within worldly Christian denominations?

Thus I have given three very good <u>Biblical</u> reasons why <u>not</u> to use the word "Saint"!

So, another point Ruth is misleading us with – and that is within the 1st two sentences or her talk!

Not looking good for the next five days – is it!

Now Paul wrote quite profusely on love and several forms of it in many locations – I choose just two – but the second quote is the reference to which Ruth is speaking.

One is located at Rom.13v8-10.

Owe no man anything, but to love one another, for he that loves another has fulfilled the law. For this you should not commit adultery, you shall not kill, you shall not steal, you shall not bear false witness, you shall not covert, and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, You shall love your neighbour as yourself. Love works no ill to his neighbour; therefore love is the fulfilling of The Law.

But perhaps the greatest section being "The More Excellent Way" is located at 1Cor.13.1-13.

Though I speak with the tongues of men (= Paul was multi-lingual) and of angels (= Paul was a messenger of God), and not have Charity (love), I am become as a sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal (= nothing of substance). And though I have the gift of prophecy (as given in his epistles), and understand all mysteries (as explained in his epistles – particularly Hebrews), and all knowledge (as demonstrated); and though I have all faith (fidelity/assurance) so that I could remove mountains (inasmuch Yahweh instructing Paul [as a <u>faithful</u> relay] to "remove mountains" – thus it would be Yahweh's holy spirit and <u>not</u> Paul), and not have charity (love), I am nothing.

And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor (which he did), and though I give my body to be burned (offering his body as an alter sacrifice to Yahweh – and metaphorically he did by imitating Jesus) and have not charity (love), it profits me nothing (in Yahweh's audit of Paul's work – being "The Interest" in Paul's talents). Charity (love) is long suffering (absorb the buffeting from The World or the disappointment by those rejecting his knowledge), and is kind (to assist your neighbour physically as "the good Samaritan" – also spiritually in understanding The Knowledge), charity (love) envies not (having no interest in the worldly self-indulgence of others); charity (love) vaunts not itself (= not a social climber), is not puffed up (not boastful about one's capabilities), does not behave itself unseemly (behaves in a respectful manner during social intercourse), seeks not her own (= not partisan), is not easily provoked (remains calm – so as not to aggravate any situation when God's Word is explained), thinks no evil (desires not to hurt any human), rejoices not in iniquity (enjoying the fallout from those sinning), but rejoices in The Truth (overjoyed in preaching and when a human becomes part of The Brethren), bears all things (pain and suffering from the environment while imitating Jesus), believes all things (scriptural – unlike many religious leaders stating today they do not), expects all things (being The Millennial Expectation), endures all things (that the

worldly religious leaders throw at a <u>True</u> Christian – exposing their hypocrisy). Charity (love) never fails (dependable between all humans), but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail (= become fulfilled in time and thus completed); whether be tongues (all languages of the present world), they shall cease (in The Millennium there shall only be one language – for one resurrected family) whether be knowledge (being the understanding of The Truth of Yahweh's Plan), it shall vanish away (when Yahweh's Plan is completed). For we know in part (because not everything about The Millennium is presently known), and we prophesy in part (for we are not to completely reveal all to the world). But when that reached is perfected (culmination of Yahweh's Plan), then that which is in part shall be done away (= The Gospel Age where <u>demonstrable</u> 144000 are being collected by Yahweh ready for The Millennium). When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things (self explanatory). For now (during The Gospel Age while having Jesus' <u>presence</u>) we see through glass darkly (the vista of The Millennium not precisely understood); but then face to face (as a bride with her bridegroom of Christ Jesus as a son of God [King/priest]); now I know in part (of what his roles will be as a prime leader in The Millennium); but then shall I know (precisely what Paul shall be doing as a <u>teacher/leader</u> [king/priest] when resurrected into that position) even as also I am known (as a <u>teacher/leader</u> to my flock of The Brethren). And now abides faith, expectation, charity (love), these three; but the greatest of these is charity (love).

(Because "faith/assurance/fidelity" towards something that 'is to occur' will not be required when it <u>has</u> occurred, "expectation" for something to occur is also not required because The Millennium would then be instituted – but "charity love" must endure forever where all <u>successful</u> humans are to express charity love to their neighbour for an eternity to create the successful society).

His words are probably some of the best known in the bible.

Ruth has just clearly demonstrated that she does not know them that well at all – inasmuch she is unable to correctly use them within context (by quoting the world later) nor understand them (quoting her in the next section) – only because she has been brainwashed by that all covering worldly Christian doctrine that has clouded her vision of "The Millennium" being the very thing that Jesus has commanded her to speak about!

Hence I have superimposed my explanations in italics for her and her peers benefit - and them to start doing! And she is supposed to be teaching us! (What Yahweh Desires?)

They are beautiful words and very poetic. But when we come to really read them, to try to grasp what is being said, they're actually quite difficult, just as love can sometimes be quite difficult.

They are only "actually quite difficult" if you have a worldly personality. If you have 'the correct personality' being the one we are <u>instructed to attain</u> – then they become quite easy to understand (and my explanations further understanding).

This is answered on two fronts – most importantly understanding Yahweh's Plan then guides you to realise that humans fail because they are like lost sheep without a shepherd (to quote Jesus) and likewise I feel the same emotion as did Jesus when surveying this sorrowful state of affairs!

The reason is that the reformed person actually looks beyond 'the immediate' because they are looking deeper into the person knowing that particular person has skewed reasoning by still being part of The World (that worldly Christian teaching only exasperates). Perhaps if reform is possible then they too could ultimately imitate Jesus. However it might require The Millennium being where society as a whole is operating in the manner shown to us by Jesus during his ministry. That is why Jesus gave us The Undeserved Gift being his Ransom Sacrifice to give ALL of us this second, but last opportunity to reform our personality – to become like Jesus! This is where we truly learn to "believe in Jesus" by "imitating Jesus" to attain eternal life!

Oh – I am now starting to preach about Yahweh's Acceptable Year in only some 80 words – but will Ruth teach us in her talks/prayers of some 1700 words?

They are challenging words.

Certainly if you are a <u>worldly</u> person – for a worldly person is seeking self-indulgence from what The World is able to deliver, the consequence of this makes 'the present god of this world' become their god! As The Bible teaches us in so many places – that present god of this <u>failing</u> worldly system is Satan – that is <u>why</u> it <u>is</u> failing (irrespective of what <u>false worldly</u> religious leaders might state). It is because of humans' "stiff-necked" response to Yahweh's Word that requires society in this worldly system to fail <u>before</u> Jesus rules in The Millennium. Jesus' rule in The Millennium will show <u>all</u> of us how the whole of society (being all its members within it – in every country) prospers <u>without</u> the present pain and suffering – when <u>all</u> entities follow Yahweh's Instruction, rather than Satan's instruction of putting 'the self' first.

So after that understanding, hopefully Ruth is not speaking for herself – but rather what she witnesses within The World today by those humans who follow after the god of this world – Satan – by imitating him in their works of putting 'the self' first before their neighbours' interests!

A pandemic practice where we all (including me) have done this at least once in our life – and thus "fallen short of The Law" and become under "The Curse of Satan" – released only by Jesus' Gift of self-sacrifice.

They're certainly not about a romantic feeling where it's roses all the way, with no encounters with conflict or change or stretching.

Sadly Ruth has fallen into the same trap as her worldly peers. She has <u>not</u> explained that there are at least four different Greek words for "Love" to her listener. The listener probably only knows of "Eros" form of "love" being a self-indulgent love given to humans to procreate and thus fill the earth (as commanded) – but is unaware of the three other forms of "love" in The Greek text. Please see "Love" in the Glossary to see this term fully explained. When this confusion is removed, then the listener would understand <u>why</u> there is conflict while we 'learn' from the world within what has now become the 1st part of our life.

In fact, when we look at the way St Paul defines love in this letter to the Corinthian Christians, we either shy away from it, or else make a decision, an act of will to follow its way, no matter what - always,

Sounds just 'so nice' – but it is <u>not</u> exactly what The Bible teaches us – being more confusion given by Ruth – and a very common distortion promulgated by her worldly peers.

Jesus taught his disciples how to preach to The World being their demonstration of Real Love where they put themselves out to fulfil Yahweh's Desire by imitating Jesus (and did <u>not</u> follow the ways of The World). Stay with a group of <u>new</u> recipients for a while if they listened, or if they should not listen then "shake *the dust* off their own feet" signifying *worldly* rejection, and then move on to find someone who would be interested in The Word of God.

Also Paul taught that there were certain individuals who should be left to The World – for it might go better for them if they were <u>not</u> brought into The Truth. The knowledge of The Millennium explains precisely why. And finally we are taught by example that Jesus was very caustic to certain Religious Leaders – he certainly did <u>not</u> show "the love" to them that Ruth is insinuating that we should, if we were to follow what Paul teaches us being an extension of what Jesus initiated. So immediately there are <u>three</u> Biblical examples that <u>contradict</u> her explanation – purely because she and her peers do <u>not</u> understand Yahweh's Plan which logically removes all these <u>apparent</u> contradictions. But Ruth and her peers' doctrine cannot righteously explain these apparent contradictions and thus they hide behind what they often state when stuck in a hole: "it is a mystery"!

I believe, with the help of God. It would be impossible in our own strength.

It is what Ruth 'believes', and sounds really great! – But again it is a quaint spin upon what The Bible actually teaches us when placed back into Bible context!

There are just so many examples of this spiel given by representatives of <u>all worldly religions</u>. It is also quotable of worldly leaders at political rallies in any given country within the world, and thus it's over usage utterly devalues any of its original integrity.

Interestingly, humble/righteous Christians never even declare this publically – because they know it inside – and are utterly subservient to Yahweh within their lifestyle – thus it is unnecessary to state the obvious – especially when displayed within their works – seen by others as being 'different'! I would like to direct the reader to what Paul said on the subject at 2Cor.12v9-11, because he qualifies it superbly in his teachings and <u>not</u> in a worldly sense as stated here and repeated as mantra in just so many other places within the world.

The Bible teaches us that a <u>True</u> Christian <u>avoids worldly politics like the plague</u> – I show how and why supported by several Bible quotes elsewhere to <u>fully substantiate</u> what I state here.

Thus with that background – we conclude that what Ruth has stated should be ignored – because unless this statement has demonstrable substance being The Fruits thereof (which Paul demonstrated) then it is <u>from</u> The World designed to <u>mislead the listener</u>, being said <u>without</u> sincerity – thus being a rally call used by a charlatan to feign an inadequacy as a cover for those that they might not desire to change!

The American theologian Eugene Peterson's paraphrase of Paul's words might well shake us out of any complacency caused by their very familiarity:

So Ruth prefers to quote The World rather than The Apostle Paul as we witness. – I know who I would rather quote (and do) – being Paul a person who Yahweh endorsed, demonstrated by his works – showing his **real love** to his neighbour where he put himself out by imitating Jesus' ministry by works rather than <u>just</u> words. If we could see more of that type of a <u>genuine</u> personality change today of Christ-Like works rather than verbose words 'sowing-in confusion', then this world would be a much better place – <u>only</u> because people would then actually know with clarity what The Goal was and how to get to it!

Love never gives up
Love cares more for others than for self.
Love doesn't want what it doesn't have.
Love doesn't strut,
Doesn't have a swelled head,
Doesn't force itself on others,
Isn't always 'me first'
Doesn't fly off the handle,
Doesn't keep score of the sins of others
Trusts God always,
Always looks for the best,

Never looks back, But keeps going to the end.

A poor imitation of what Paul stated – having nothing of the future Expectation, about which Ruth has been commanded to speak to her neighbour by Jesus! As I stated elsewhere – this could have been written by someone of <u>ANY worldly</u> religion – of which there are many! And further may I ask Ruth – how many people of the <u>worldly</u> Christian religion actually practice precisely what is stated here? And if they do not precisely adhere to what has been stated here then does that mean they are cut-off from becoming a citizen of "the Kingdom"? (More later).

Why do I state that?

Because of what I quoted in 1Cor.13.13. where love endures for all time (= an eternity), where the converse is that if humans cannot do this for all time then they cannot be in the kingdom for an eternity.

My first conundrum for Ruth – there are several raised in her sequence of talks – more later.

Dear God, would you give me your grace to love like that.

I carefully explain in detail why the contents of this prayer would not be endorsed by Yahweh, and there is <u>no</u> prayer example anywhere in The Bible that teaches us to pray like that – please carefully review The Lord's Prayer being The Model Prayer. Please see my essay entitled "Why do we pray" that covers many of these points. I also cover this later and elsewhere on this now very large website.

And this day, help me to reveal to someone that they are beautiful. Amen

Yes Ruth - by <u>accurately</u> teaching and quoting The Word of God <u>in context</u> so 'that someone' might know how to reform their personality to begin imitating Jesus' lifestyle in order to become like Jesus and thus <u>truly</u> beautiful before Yahweh. For Yahweh stated: "This is My son in whom I am well pleased – <u>listen to him</u>" (= imitate him by <u>doing</u> what he teaches you - for he is The Word of God). You cannot get more beautiful before Yahweh than the subject of that statement!

Let us move onto the next day and see what that holds in store for us.

and with God

<u>Not</u> in western society where <u>worldly</u> religion has shown itself to be an absolute farce. <u>Worldly</u> Christianity being 'The Message' portrayed as a charade by errant messengers fulfilling their self-indulgencies by fornicating with The World has polluted The Word of God to make Yahweh God <u>appear</u> to be an utter irrelevance to society. Clearly when there is trouble beyond the power of man – then humans cry out <u>vainly</u> to "God" for help – but <u>is</u> He really going to listen to those humans who have <u>ignored</u> His Statutes (= imitate Jesus' lifestyle) when life was 'easy' going for self-indulgence?

Clearly He <u>will ignore them</u> – just as He ignores yearly international prayer days for peace driven by 'two-faced' leaders (both political and worldly religious).

<u>But Yet</u> Yahweh is carefully crafting His Parallel plan of redemption where He <u>does</u> listen to and responds positively to those 144000 <u>individuals</u> who <u>are</u> fulfilling His desire by <u>imitating</u> Jesus' lifestyle during The Gospel

Age. Being those individuals who put themselves out to <u>accurately</u> preach and teach The Word of God – being also the harsh parts for that all important personality reform and also the good/kind/loving parts being the fruits of the spirit when that personality has been reformed and adopted within the individual.

is what most of us yearn for

The reality is actually shown up by The Evidence in The World today. The majority 'lord it' over those beneath them to satisfy their self indulgent nature. This is practiced within and without countries. Name any subject, Economic, Trade, Sex, 'General human intercourse' within any of the three pillars of commerce, politics and religion, and there are **billions** of examples **daily** where humans are self-indulgent over their neighbour. May there be kindness in your gaze when you look within.

Paul pummeled his body to travel to that next village when exhausted to preach The Word of God to someone new! Thus his kindness was to The World rather than towards himself. He was <u>not</u> self-indulgent.

And rather than just "gazing and looking" – he was a man of action/work!

May you never place walls between the light and yourself.

Does this mean "light" being "The Knowledge of God"?

How many of those listening would understand that?

And analyse these two lines, both are promoting passivity – an anathema to Yahweh.

Is this the 'one talent' man speaking?

And as we come to know ourselves in a new way,

If we imitate Jesus – but how many people do that today?

We are instructed to audit ourselves against The Bible and not against other people. Thus we push ourselves to 100% of our ability which may be at differing levels between humans.

perhaps a new confidence will come to reach out to others.

Hopefully that comes out from within my writings!

One of the things that gives most pleasure in life is looking forward to something. It could be a well-deserved holiday after a long period of hard work, or a special event in your life, or the return of someone you love after a long absence. As the day draws nearer, it can seem as if your whole being is on tiptoe with expectancy.

I am fervently looking forward to The Millennium with the same Expectation that Paul had and his fellow apostles! Is Ruth going to mention it now – for that is what Jesus commanded of us. He showed us by demonstration and Paul instructed us to imitate him as he imitated Jesus.

There estrangement can creep in if we have confused loving with meeting certain expectations. When what we hoped for from the other doesn't materialise, the gap between us can widen very quickly.

Ruth – you have now just swung into reinforcing <u>worldly</u> traits rather than guiding us to what The Bible teaches us. Focus on what The Bible teaches us about "Love" and personal relationships.

Is this going to occur?

Let us see.

The Irish writer John O'Donohue has a blessing for those who dare to see beyond the times of disappointment and keep trusting.

Oh dear! – A golden opportunity to quote The Bible and Ruth quotes a worldly source!

Well let us see what John is to teach us.

Now is the time for one of you to be gracious,

"Gracious" actually means "presenting gifts and favours"

I have stated this because most people do <u>not</u> know what this word really means – because they are <u>not</u> taught by those who claim to know!

A number of years ago, there was a very popular poster. It pictured a caterpillar hanging on a branch of a tree. The caption underneath was, "Please be patient. God hasn't finished with me yet!" To hang on to the fact that God hasn't finished with any of us can be a source of continuing hope and encouragement. So no matter how many side roads we travel down, no matter how many times we stumble, I'm convinced the God who is faithful

...... To His Absolute Perfection expressed through His holy spirit (see Glossary).

But His sphere of influence covers The Whole Universe, so there is nowhere for any other entity to hide from His influence – thus those entities who practice iniquity (having The Knowledge – but persist in the enjoyment of sinning) shall be removed from Yahweh's sphere of influence = total annihilation (to be in the position not to even realise they had been annihilated!).

This is Yahweh's Plan to fruition:

At present the <u>vast majority</u> of The World does <u>not</u> have 'The Knowledge' and thus have The Millennium being the 2nd part of their life in which they will be taught 'The Knowledge' – to which they <u>must</u> then adhere for salvation. This paragraph is just running upon quotations from The Bible.

We are told in James.1v6-8 that Yahweh will <u>not</u> work with a two minded person, being a person who flits between The World and Yahweh – for this is "adultery" practiced by a person who is supposedly betrothed to Yahweh's son Jesus.

Can the reader understand how all these 'quoted' verses in The Bible come together in The Most Logical fashion? - With zero contradictions!

And I'm convinced too that every day can be a new beginning.

Yes it <u>can</u> be - provided we throw away our old personality and put on metaphoric white clothing (see Glossary) by imitating Jesus to fulfil Yahweh's Desire.

No matter what yesterday was like, no matter what anxieties we face up ahead, this moment, this day has been given to us - and we have a choice as to how we live it.

Correct! – That is the free choice given to each one of us. Yahweh does <u>not</u> desire zombies – but <u>free thinking</u> entities who innately <u>yearn</u> to fufil Yahweh's Desire that ultimately produces the most righteous operating society. If we enter the task with defeat and despair – then we are <u>not</u> worthy vessels for Yahweh to work with. Jesus taught us by his parable about the man starting to build his tower without assessing his resources beforehand. Also about the two armies where the wise leader did assess his resources and sought terms of agreement (a human assessing that he can only take upon himself 2 talents rather than the full 5 talents which Jesus gave <u>according to</u> their ['negotiated'] abilities).

The trust and <u>expectation</u> comes from detailed and accurate knowledge. This only comes from hard work beforehand – but once having this knowledge then you are expected by Yahweh to use it profitably <u>and</u> He is making a continual assessment during The Special/Greater Judgment that He is conduction on <u>all</u> humans who call themselves "Christians". Those humans given more talents – then more "interest" from work shall be expected. Those who work hard in the service of Jesus being their single master (by not being distracted by a second – worldly master) reinforces The Expectation of The Inheritance within their rationale that becomes The Drive to continue fulfilling Yahweh's Desire.

The Good News is that we do not journey through this day or this life alone,

With fellow humans – being "birds of a feather flock together" as we so choose, where perhaps occasionally "Jesus comes knocking at the door to dine with us" see Rev.3v20.

I really have not a clue what is being taught here – nor to even be in the position to comment upon it! Except to quote The Bible: "The Truth has set you free" so that we might not fear this worldly system anymore! "All this is too big for me.

No Ruth! – The Bible just tells us <u>not</u> to do it!

There's nothing I, as an ordinary individual, can do to make any significant difference for good in this world.

The Bible teaches us what we as individuals are to do with our lives.

Learn what The Bible teaches and then The Knowledge will supply The Confidence, for we are told that Yahweh's holy spirit will "cause our memories to remember" and "speak for us" – provided we are acting to fulfil Yahweh's Desire as a true apostle – else Yahweh will <u>not</u> be working with us (if we are self-indulgent).

This is an <u>individual responsibility</u> – but sadly <u>worldly</u> Christian Leaders seem to desire the monopoly on knowledge (as do some worldly academics for 'the security' it gives them) and do not instruct their congregations to specifically what The Bible commands – that we learn The Knowledge from a young age.

I will let those religious leaders find that paraphrase in the Bible to have an opportunity to 'get to know' The Bible in their studies. I give them a clue – it is in The New Testament!

But there's another way of viewing and looking at life. It involves a total renewing of our way of thinking,

Excellent! – This is the <u>most</u> important thing Ruth has yet stated – will she start to promote what we <u>all</u> should be doing! Please read this website to understand precisely what we <u>all</u> should be doing.

so that we see things through the eyes of those who dwell in the upside-down kingdom of God.

Ruth has just blown a golden opportunity completely away!

Replaced it with classic worldly wisdom! I am forced to untangle this reasoning elsewhere.

Yahweh's kingdom of The Universe is <u>not</u> upside down – but utterly structured and ordered!

Jesus as "the specific god" of us will structure The World into a righteous society in The Millennium.

If anything is upside down then it is this world under Satan's stewardship, so that those humans <u>operating within it</u> (interesting concept) view 'straight and ordered things <u>outside</u> their environment' as being "the upside-down kingdom of God". I assume that makes a statement about how Ruth and her peers view Yahweh's World of Righteous Order.

St. Paul

The Apostle Paul

says, in one of his letters, that it's something to do with God deliberately choosing those who are powerless to shame those who are powerful, choosing things despised by the world in order to bring to nothing what the world considers important.

Just as I stated earlier – let me now clarify.

This will occur **when** The Millennium is installed by Jesus.

Paul told us this in 2Tim.4v6-8 that he had finished the good fight and is ready to receive kingship/priesthood upon resurrection. Having demonstrated his faithful stewardship as being powerless in the 1st part of his life (weak body and position) becomes resurrected with The Power reserved solely for a Son of God where Paul's new position will shame those worldly religious leaders having power in Satan's World pretending to represent Yahweh's interests during the 1st part of their life!

But in pursuance of "The Kingdom" as this should be our aim.

Then is Ruth suggesting that <u>only</u> 'those people who are <u>not</u> in powerful places' will become citizens of "The Kingdom"? Because without explanation – that is all the listener can assume!

That throws away all the top layers throughout Christendom! Does it not?

So a very interesting conundrum is raised.

If the top echelons of <u>all</u> Christendom 'know' The Bible – and surely they do – else clearly they would not be in that position (?) – then why would they want to take that position if 'what they know' means that they automatically become <u>in</u>eligible to be citizens of The Kingdom that they supposedly espouse – that really is a conundrum – is it not!

While Ruth may be unable to explain that conundrum – I certainly cover it in much detail on this website – where I very carefully and accurately explain the precise solution in the most logical fashion.

One of the least extolled, but most necessary, virtues in life is that of endurance, of simply gritting your teeth and keeping on going, even when there is very little or no obvious encouragement to do so.

Especially true when the apostle is going through the small/tight gate while those worldly Christians aim for the large/open gate (for as we are told this parable is only referring to Christians of The Gospel Age and not those of other religions, nor atheists – I leave it to those wise scholars to determine what words make this fact crystal clear – but I do explain it elsewhere on this website in context – being a clue to 'the finding of it').

And yet we can get a sense that God has entrusted us with something in our lives.

He most certainly has – <u>we ARE to imitate Jesus</u> – and <u>nothing else</u> – thus throw away all <u>worldly</u> customs created by the <u>worldly</u> seeking church which ultimately devalue The Ministry work of God. For it was <u>not</u> Jesus nor his apostles who introduced all the ideas of pilgrimages, "lighting of candles", dress, trinkets, precedence, "colour of the collection bag to be used on certain occasions", 'the list is utterly <u>endless</u>' – these things are <u>despised</u> by Yahweh for they 'take the eye off the <u>real</u> ball' as Jesus taught about The Pharisees being more interested in the tiny things rather than the weighty matters concerning life and death, also his comment on The Scribes walking through the market place in their garb and the trinkets hanging off them – are all specifically and even more so applicable today! I remember one comment made after 'the ordination of women' vote was passed in the synod was: What would the dress be like for newly ordained women? – I just groaned! They had just ignored what the Bible taught us in one thing and then compounded it by ignoring another statement in The Bible – all for self-indulgence!

It might be only a flickering awareness of some gift or grace or calling, but it's there.

If that is all it is – just "only a flickering" then it will 'flicker out'!

As we are told by Paul we are "to lean forward and grasp The Prize". We are to exert ourselves for The Goal.

We are to pummel our body in the furtherance of Yahweh's Desire to Preach The Word of God (not for masochistic reasons practiced by some deviants – 'the reasoning' sourced by Satan to confuse).

When "grace" = "gifts and favours" why then does Ruth use the word "or" if they mean the same thing? Then uses the words "or calling" being "An Invitation" by Jesus if he sees potential. However it then becomes <u>our personal responsibility to do something with it</u> thus become mature adults rather than remaining as babes constantly feeding on milk!

<u>Do not go to them</u> – for Jesus told his apostles (= appointed by Yahweh to tell) "it is given to you to know" (by Yahweh), but not to the population at large. So go to those who know – seems the most sensible thing to do!

But the fact of the matter is: you and I are here for a purpose.

Yes absolutely Ruth – but for what?

The purpose primarily is to 'be yourself',

Absolutely NOT!

The Bible tells us to reform ourselves.

The Bible teaches us to <u>put on a new clothing</u> = a new personality

The Bible teaches us to imitate Jesus.

The Bible teaches us to <u>learn and inculcate what we have been taught into our life.</u>

Paul tells us to <u>copy him as he copies Jesus</u>.

The Bible most certainly does <u>not</u> teach that 'we are to be ourselves' – this is an utter travesty of The Truth! The whole Bible tenure is one of transformation of the synapse construction from a worldly attitude of 'The Self' to a heavenly attitude where one's neighbours' interests are placed before your own – this is a radical reform!

to be as fully as possible the unique person God has created you to be.

<u>This is utter rubbish!</u> Being merely worldly wisdom – which we hear often given by the <u>worldly</u> wise!" Jesus created the fleshly body that was perfect in its physical construction but after sin was introduced by Adam and Eve, then it began to fail for it had no access to the necessary enzymes from "The Tree of Life" to sustain its system support mechanism – thus DNA failure ensued to create "The 'Junk' DNA" within our genome.

Jesus also created a brain wherein it was able to process information "like us" = "like Jesus and Yahweh" = "like gods" that separated us from animals. We can lack confidence and can be so fearful about taking a step into an unknown future,

Commit to educating yourself in The Bible – being a <u>good</u> translation <u>having **fidelity** to The Original Word</u> (Hebrew and Greek) - but <u>not an interpretation</u> as with <u>all</u> bibles put out in the last 50 or so years – avoid them like the plague for any form of analytical work.

Please use my translation of The Greek New Testament that I created only because I could <u>not</u> trust what was out there because of errant translations (being a spin placed upon the original Greek translation) that I could rectify and also bring these anomalies to the attention of the reader.

As I have stated earlier, having knowledge gives confidence being The Assurance. Though I do <u>not</u> like this phrase from <u>a worldly sense</u> it is still correct – "Knowledge is Power" and assurance comes from this known power. Because this is poetic and thus completely metaphoric – it is positively <u>dangerous</u> to those humans who do not intimately know The Bible as I am able to recall. Sadly worldly humans will automatically associate "limited horizons" and "wide open spaces" with connotations delivered by The Worldly reasoning – being what is 'plugged' into our senses by those stealing our reasoning for their own advantage, for example adverts, leaders, '(worldly) wise councilors', politicians, etc.

Only because not all humans are likely to put their neighbour <u>before</u> their own interests (in fact few people actually lower themselves unless forced by circumstance/return) – thus they could use this sentence to endorse their misguided works – to cover anything!

The point I am making is that you can spin this sentence to excuse any (worldly) action!

Thus it is a weak statement – but an example of a pandemic problem of today.

Do not allow your confusion to squander

What confusion? – Having The Absolute Truth gives clarity to thought to any worldly problem.

Jesus only becomes "the stumbling stone" to a <u>worldly</u> Christian (and "*crushes*" a <u>worldly</u> Christian *Leader* because they are *judged* upon what they claim to know) and thus explains this terminology when Jesus quoted this about himself.

This call which is loosening Your roots in false ground,

To the listener – this whole piece is confusing! What call is loosening what?

Is it a call that is confusing you being a call to The World or The call of Jesus knocking at the door?

Being a melting pot of mixed emotions at some critical decision point in one's life. There is no guidance here! And "the false ground"? If it is false ground then you should be loosened from it to find some firm ground given to us by understanding what The Bible instructs of us. But if having <u>no</u> knowledge of The Bible (being my specific point) then how is a worldly person going to be in the position to know if they are on false ground?

They can only base their judgment upon knowledge gain from The Environment = experience - and if they do not read The Bible to find out about The Absolute Knowledge, then how can they know firm ground?

Which is where those who claim to be ambassadors of Yahweh should start representing Yahweh correctly – and start giving the correct information!

So we can imaging anything might be going through a worldly listener's mind.

There is no clarity in this message – but Satan delights in 'fog' to distort the clarity of The Bible's message. Do we read of anything like this poetic 'fog' in The Bible? - Clearly Not! For Yahweh only promotes clarity.

That you might come free

From all you had outgrown.

Free from what you have outgrown?

To play devil's advocate – that person might reason I have grown up from a babe, I can now use knives to defend/promote myself, smoke cigarettes, drink myself silly, swear and assert myself upon my neighbour now I am bigger and stronger!

Is this the type of message that Ruth is endorsing to a listener's ear? – Hopefully not!

But what else is she placing within the listener's mind? - Utterly nothing!

I am trying to demonstrate the utter emptiness of this <u>worldly</u> wisdom – diametrically opposed to what The Bible instructs of its readers/listeners!

Dear God, I want to be true to you

If you <u>really</u> "want to be true to" Yahweh then <u>imitate Jesus</u>. But first I know that you need to reform your synapse construction! To achieve this very necessary reform then read and understand the contents of this website. <u>Then</u> go out and accurately fulfil Yahweh's Desire when you have this knowledge.

and your dream for me,

What is Ruth saying?

Yahweh does **not** dream!

Yahweh directs all proceedings and He knows the end before the beginning!

So can Ruth kindly explain to me how Yahweh "dreams"?

no matter what the obstacles.

Though Ruth is not saying this I would like it 'for the record' that Yahweh does not place obstacles in a person's path in life provided they fulfil His Desire, neither does Yahweh tempt any person.

This is what The Bible teaches us.

The Bible also teaches us Yahweh is quick to save those humans who struggle to imitate His son Jesus.

The Bible also teaches us that Yahweh destroys those humans who are iniquitous.

The Bible also teaches us that Yahweh ignores those humans who ignore fulfilling His Desire.

I suggest Ruth carefully 'ruminates'/meditates upon this knowledge.

Today I give you my hopes and dreams and visions

I assume she is speaking to 'God' about herself.

However personally, I would be very worried if I was a worldly person and Ruth had me in her sights! But in writing this piece I have Ruth in my sights – but only in Real Love – to cause her (and those millions upon millions who are misled by this present world) to seriously consider their present flawed understanding – with all its holes and contradictions as I have shown in spending many hours upon hours carefully going through this piece. I am trying to redirect those reasoning centres that separate us from animals that enable us to think like 'gods' to understand what Jesus is really teaching us about the past, present and future - being all contained within The Bible and not elsewhere.

trusting that you will take care of who you are calling me to be.

I do not understand what Ruth means here!

The Bible has told Ruth what she is supposed to be like!

And being a reverend and Dr (I suppose of divinity) then she should know precisely what Yahweh Desires of her. The very fact that she speaks like this means that Jesus <u>has</u> become her stumbling stone, and she is kicking against him – for she has obvious worldly traits that shackle and thus control her reasoning.

She has not yet broken free to become an apostle.

Amen

How can Yahweh endorse this prayer?

That is why we have The Millennium – so that those humans who have not the strength of The Vision of The Inheritance might become part of the inheritance upon their resurrection.

That is the safety net – if they had The Vision of The Inheritance and acted appropriate as such during the 1st part of their life, then they would become resurrected as a Son of God to <u>attain</u> The Inheritance rather than just be <u>part</u> of The Inheritance.

Now the reader has completed 'the critique' of Ruth's talks/prayers.

These series of talks/prayers just reciting in a confused manner about "love", "confidence", 'a new person', 'the lure of small becoming great', 'overcoming obstacles' and not much else here - would have <u>also</u> been given by the religious leaders operating in the day of Jesus' ministry.

How can I state this? Because Jerusalem was a major city – and most empires aimed for its conquest, please read The Old Testament to find out!

Also Hindu travellers would be there, together with representatives of Buddha all trading in commerce and religion. Then The Greeks with their gods had been there for some 300 years, and The Romans with their gods during Jesus' day!

So Ruth and her peers need to answer that fundamental question – being one of uniqueness!

But they do not, rather many <u>worldly</u> acclaimed Christian Scholars actually muddy the waters by mixing all these religions together stating that one fed the other!

Is this really what Jesus did, or even desires to hear publicised today by those 'so eminent' scholars puffed up with worldly wisdom (bolstered by their worldly doctorates of divinity given by The World for The World)! Clearly not!

<u>Worldly</u> Christian scholars are unable to even realise that Yahweh and Jesus are utterly separate individuals as I very carefully explain on this website with documental evidence taken from The Source (= The Bible that they <u>should</u> know) precisely tells us These Entities <u>are</u> different – but they still muddy the waters by mixing these distinctly two separately reasoning Entities all together in the worldly myth called The Trinity (please see Glossary and dissertations on this subject on this website.

Clearly the obvious is to speak about "Love" – but it was so well covered by Paul that was not quoted by Ruth. I could explain all the different types of "Love" – but I have already covered that aspect in Glossary under "Love". Perhaps the most appropriate would be to explain how The Knowledge changes the personality of a worldly human. Let us see what that delivers.

Humans physically come in all shapes and sizes – which can be so easy to see. Likewise humans also come metaphorically in all shapes and sizes' being how they process stimuli from the local environment – but this is so much more difficult see from afar. Normally much time would need to be spent with an individual to understand 'how they tick'. While humans may find it difficult to disguise their physical appearance upon a first glance, they find covering their true intention (a subset of personality) for a short period of time much easier and some humans are so skilled as to cover their motives to make gain from their innocent victims.

Jesus gave us a most useful tool that is able to cut through the religious charlatan's disguise. Jesus told us to look at their fruitage, and if the fruitage fulfils Yahweh's Desire then this person has fidelity to Yahweh's Word and should be respected and thus trusted.

Starting as experimenting children, certain techniques were tried and those that bore positive results would be rehearsed in a habitual fashion that can lead to self-indulgence depending upon how The Environment, Parents and Peers react to this behaviour. Clearly, why should a person change their methodology when it pays dividends, and they behave as they did while young – which in many instances would be in a self-indulgent manner. This will continue until a step change occurs within their life to invoke a personality reassessment.

However a self-indulgent lifestyle at the expense of your neighbour is not how Yahweh Desires entities within His Universe to behave – for it leads to 'controlled chaos' as we witness operating within this present pariah world. Neither does our creator Jesus, so he lowered himself below his creation by volunteering his very existence to preach Yahweh's Word and become The Wisdom of God by his lifestyle abiding by what he taught. He then became The Ransom Sacrifice so that all humans had one last opportunity after their resurrection to change their lifestyle to become like that of Jesus. This is to occur in The Millennium when all humans resurrected have an opportunity to live in a righteous society and 'get to like it'. In 'getting to like it' 'reason will take over' and humans will discard their old personality and take on the new personality.

In doing so, then they shall have the opportunity to live for an eternity in perfected DNA bodies.

Paul taught us a more excellent way being the practice of charity Love where we put our neighbour's interests before our own. In this manner we imitate Jesus' ministry period within our own life which through Jesus' Ransom Sacrifice actually becomes the 1st part of our life. By doing this we imitate Paul's ministry where he uses the example of a race to explain we are to exert ourselves to win the race by pushing forward to grasp for The Prize.

What is the prize for those specific humans who imitate Jesus during the 1st part of their physical life?

The prize is a resurrection to sonship of Yahweh God to become a son of God – just like Jesus is now – because in Yahweh's assessment of the 1st part of our life we imitated our master. We shall then have the "trusted stewards" given responsibility over 5 or 10 cities given in Jesus' Parable being the teaching work in The Millennium. That is The Goal of which Yahweh Desires for all entering The Race to attain – but we are told only 144000 are significantly worthy to be elevated into this position demonstrated by them winning The Race.

Yahweh God Omnificent Master of The Universe – my vocabulary is too limited to express Your Grandness and my thanks for Your Plan so succinctly and perfectly enacted by Jesus to give all humans a second opportunity to realign their synapse construction within a perfected society so that they might fill Your Granary in The Culmination. So just a sincere "Thank You" is all that I can state.

That is my offering for "Prayer for the day". It has skewed to much of what I state on this website elsewhere but that is what Jesus taught being "The Acceptable Year of The Lord" being 'the growth of seed to harvest'. It is from the planting in the ground, germinating in the soil (= the 1st part of our life in the darkness of Satan). Then when we shoot above the ground to bask into the sun (= our resurrection into The Millennium in the light of Yahweh's Word accurately taught to us) where we grow to our harvest. "The harvest" being the final 3.5 year assessment (when Satan is released for a short while) that parallels Jesus' ministry period under Satan's control (that demonstrated Jesus' perfection) – likewise humans at the end of The Millennium in the final assay (harvest – either to Yahweh's Granary or to be 'burnt' to destruction at The 2nd Death).
