

The Gospel is Two Fold

The title explained in Hebrews 3v5,6. There are two classes, so the Gospel or Good News is (and must be) two fold because it is directed to two classes of people.

1. **For the majority of the population** being that God's Kingdom shall soon be set up **here on Earth** and not in the Heavens.
2. **For a few people to be leaders**, Jesus from his first coming 2000 years ago, has been:-
Calling out a people (= 144000) for His Name.
To be:- **Chosen as Kings and Priests**
To rule and teach this kingdom 'righteousness' with the King Jesus.

This Earthly Kingdom filled with resurrected humans will learn Righteousness.

By Jesus and his Priests – and not by any of the churches who are unable to perform this task now!

Remembering the Lord's Prayer, it says:-

Thy Kingdom come (*later here upon the Earth*).

Thy 'will' be done on Earth (*here and by implication everywhere upon Earth*).

as it is in to the Heavens (*now in the Heavens*)

His 'Desire/Will' (righteousness) shall be schooled into 'The World' on this Earth in The Millennium by Jesus.

Why does it Say:-

God's Kingdom to be set up, down here on Earth is The Good News?

Because:-

When Jesus comes to 'Rule' with his Priests, He will first 'Chain Satan in the pit' so the 'source' of evil will be removed. (*Metaphorically so that we can understand "Satan is restrained and has no influence over us"*).

Isa.26v19 and v9,10

Then he (*Yahweh*) shall raise all the dead from their graves to give them an opportunity to learn righteousness during the 1000 year Millennium.

Those who still wish to deal wickedly will be 'cut off' (*The 2nd and very final death of utter annihilation*).

Isa.11v4-9

Jesus ruling with an 'Iron Rod' means no more fighting and killing.

So **no** more sin and suffering, **no** more sorrow and sighing. Under the 'King of Kings and his Priests the whole world will be at peace.

Rev.20v14

Death and the grave are destroyed.

Isa.11v4-9

The Earth will no-more 'cover her slain' (in graves).

Clearly these passages show that there will be no more dying.

This is why it is Good News to the majority:-

The poor and the meek of this Earth.

Why does The Bible continually say The Good News is for the poor and meek?

Because:-

Most of the ordinary and all the rich are now content with **this** present worldly system of things because they yearn for more that this present world can give to them – and work harder directly for these things. They do not 'want' God's righteousness to be 'here on Earth' – else they would imitate Jesus – because that is the only way it is to occur – for that is why Jesus commanded us to do this!

Matt.19v23,24

That **a rich man shall hardly enter the kingdom** of the heavens. It is easier for a camel to go through the 'eye of a needle' (*this was a very small gate-way in the wall of Jerusalem, or the other interpretation is taken to mean "camel" being the alternative understanding for "rope"*), than for **a rich man to enter the Kingdom of God.**

1John.2v15

If any man '**loves the world**' the **love of the Father is not in him.**

John.12v25

He that loves his life shall lose it, and he that **hates his life in this world** (*to be extended to hating his own worldly actions – rather than just hating the things around him*), shall keep it **to life eternal.**

Because only one priest is required to teach a large congregation in **this 'imitation' of what God will do** in The Millennium.

It is vital for the reader to understand that The Old Physical Israel typified the New Spiritual Israel of The Gospel Age so that its members would then lead the New Worldly system in The Millennium, just as the Old Israel was to lead the Old Worldly system in BCE.

The Old Israel failed because it had a homogeneous mix of good and bad people born in the 1st part of their life, The New Israel proves itself not to fail because it is full of good people to be born (again) into their perfect life, and then as perfect individuals (Kings/Priests) they have demonstrated their righteousness (in the 1st part of their life) to now lead The New World.

Can the reader see how wonderfully executed (and will be) Almighty God's plan for us today?
It is so wonderfully planned and is being executed as you read this, precisely as I have shown!

So we should now ask ourselves what the proportion of teachers to listeners when Jesus rules with an iron rod (after he comes like a lion).

So let us use the example given to Moses on the mount perhaps may give us an approximation (as an example) to grasp the numbers.

Num. 4

We are told that the Levites (The Priestly Tribe) – The ones from whom the 'actual priests' were called to service, numbered 8580 persons. This was when **Aaron and two sons** were actual priests.

So for one Priest (which it should have been) would mean that (very approximately to give a rough working guide):-

$$8580:3 = 2800:1$$

If we use this ratio as a rough guide (in magnitude only) and apply it to the 144000 stated in Rev 7v14 as the number of priests in The Millennium we come out with a congregation of 403,200,000 (consecrated ones to assist the Kings/Priests – perhaps being the number of The Great White Multitude who come through The Great Tribulation).

It is possible to multiply this number (403,200,000) by 11 (based upon 12 tribes of Israel – but see later why) may just indicate the total number of people who will eventually pass beyond The Millennium into the 'Ages of Glory' (= entering into Yahweh's Granary).

The reasoning of the above statement:

I suggest that this is the number eventually collected from those who thought they were Christians throughout this 2000 year period. The Levites were one of the twelve tribes, so perhaps the other tribes represent those collected from the many peoples who either heard nothing of Christ or those who were 'screened' from Jesus Christ by other religions. Other tribes could be representing those who lived before Christ. The Levites were the most populace tribe. However when humans are in this position to learn The Truth then they likened to the 12 tribes of Israel by having access to Yahweh's Word.

Hence **very approximately (within an order of magnitude):-**

4,500,000,000 will be the 'Ages of Glory' total population.
